August Meeting Minutes:

The Commission reviewed the previous meeting minutes. Commissioner Sulton motioned that the meeting minutes be accepted with no revisions. Commissioner Creasman seconded the motion, and the minutes were approved by unanimous vote.

Museum Staff Report

Museum Assistant Elizabeth Lumsden introduced herself to the Commission. The Columbia Speedway exhibit opening attracted 25-30 attendees from the local area and greater region. The museum undertook a professional environmental audit on September 1. The audit, conducted by employees of the Historic Columbia Foundation and the South Carolina State Museum was focused on storage conditions and the physical conditions of the museum. The Museum collected the Lake High Catawba Pottery donation and six Confederate bills from the Midlands Coin Club. Around 20 people attended the Coin Club donation event. The Museum plans to produce a book out of the African American Legends of Cayce card series. The Staff Report concluded with the

circulation of a mockup for the new African American exhibit. The museum is soliciting funding for the exhibit from the city's accommodation tax fund. Commissioner Hayden motioned that the Museum proceed with the exhibit. Commissioner Creasman seconded the motion. The motion was approved by the unanimous vote of the Commission.

Strategic Planning

Genesis Studios is currently seeking donations for the Museum's new digital projects. We recognize a need to include a long-term maintenance program for these projects in the strategic plan.

Christmas Events

Chair Moore is organizing participants for the Christmas Open House. An organizational meeting will be held in conjunction with the Commission's regular October meeting. The Commissioners will provide food and refreshments for the volunteer decorators at 6:00. A Christmas decorating party will be held on November 22.
