Approval of Minutes:

The Augest 2022 meeting minutes were reviewed. Jim Crossland made a motion to approve and Dr. Collette Townsend-Chamber 2nd the motion. The minutes were unanimously approved.

Treasurer Report:

Kay Hutchinson briefly reviewed the foundation's current financial position.

Old Business:

Mission statement proposal

"To nurture and promote collaboration between the community and public safety departments to support safety, security, outreach and benevolence."

Jim Crossland made a motion to approve/adopt the new mission statement. Russ Shumard 2nd the motion. The new mission statement was unanimously approved by the board.

- Fall Fest update: Event canceled due to inclement weather. There will be no make-up date.
- Cayce Night Out: To take place on Oct 4, 2022 from 6 to 7 PM at Granby Gardens Park (across from the Cayce Public Safety HQ building). Members of the board were encouraged to attend the event, to assist with manning the booth selling tee shirts and promoting the foundation to the public. Plastic red fireman hats were donated to the foundation to hand out to the public.

New Business:

PD Chief Cowan

Requested funding for a tent, tablecloth etc specifically for the police department being the fire and police departments are now separate. This tent and tablecloth would be utilized at community events, job/career fairs, etc. The tent and tablecloth would have the Cayce PD insignia, badge etc. printed on them. The tent will cost \$1,010.00 and the tablecloth will cost \$125.00. Jim Crossland made a motion to approve the funding and Dori Benitez 2nd the motion. The motion was unanimously approved by the board.

• FD Chief Bullard

Requested funding for a forced entry prop training door at a cost of \$4,100.00. This equipment will be beneficial for both the FD and the PD with training scenarios related to breaching and forced entry into schools, businesses, dwellings etc. during active shooter, hostage, and similar situations. Russ Shumard made a mition to approve the funding. Dori Benitez 2nd the motion. The measure was unanimously approved by the board.

Chief Bullard also requested funding to purchase 3 "dead blow hammers" to be utilized by the FD at a cost of \$84.00 each (\$314.00 total). Chief Cowan made a motion to approve the funding and Miles Fisher 2nd the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.
