CLASS TITLE: DIESEL MECHANIC

GENERAL STATEMENT OF JOB

The purpose of the class is to perform skilled work in the maintenance, repair and modification of heavy equipment. This class works within broad policy and organizational guidelines with only occasional supervision. Reports to the Fleet Maintenance Manager.

ESSENTIAL TASKS

The tasks listed below are those that represent the majority of the time spent working in this class. Management may assign additional tasks related to the type of work of the class as necessary.

Inspects heavy vehicles and equipment for proper and safe working condition.

Performs preventive maintenance of heavy vehicles and equipment as scheduled.

Performs routine minor maintenance such as changing tires, adjusting belts, lubricating parts, changing batteries, replacing wiper blades, etc.

Perform major repairs, such as engine overhauls, transmission repair and service and repair of complex sub-assemblies such as hydraulic, electric or vacuum systems.

Modifies vehicles as necessary; installs or removes special equipment and fabricates parts as needed.

Maintains a safe, clean and orderly shop environment.

Provides advice and assistance to vehicle or equipment operators as necessary.

INVOLVEMENT WITH DATA, PEOPLE AND THINGS

DATA INVOLVEMENT:

Requires comparing or inspecting items against a standard.

PEOPLE INVOLVEMENT:

Requires speaking to people to convey or exchanging information of a general nature.

INVOLVEMENT WITH THINGS

Requires the ability to overhaul, restore, renovate, construct and/or rebuild equipment, machinery or objects, requiring adherence to prescribed standards and specifications.

COGNITIVE REQUIREMENTS

CLASS TITLE: DIESEL MECHANIC

CLASS TITLE: DIESEL MECHANIC

REASONING REQUIREMENTS:

Requires the ability to apply principles of rational systems; to interpret instructions furnished in written, oral, diagrammatic or schedule form; to exercise independent judgment to adopt or modify methods and standards to meet variations in assigned objectives.

MATHEMATICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Requires performing addition, subtraction, multiplication and division; requires using basic geometry and principles of fractions.

MENTAL REQUIREMENTS:

Requires specialized technical work requiring general understanding of operating policies and procedures and their application to problems not previously encountered; applies specialized technical principles and practices in the solution of problems; requires normal attention with short periods of concentration for accurate results and occasional exposure to unusual pressure.

JUDGMENTS AND DECISIONS

Makes frequent decisions affecting the individual, co-workers and others that depend on the service or product provided.

VOCATIONAL/EDUCATIONAL AND EXPERIENCE PREPARATION

VOCATIONAL/EDUCATIONAL PREPARATION:

Requires high school or GED and formal training, special courses or self-education equivalent to the satisfactory completion of one year of college education or specialized advanced training in heavy duty and specialized automotive mechanics or a closely related field.

SPECIAL CERTIFICATIONS AND LICENSES:

Must possess a valid South Carolina CDL driver's license.
Other special skills or equipment certifications may be required.

EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

Requires over four years and up to and including eight years of related experience.
