
## Frequently asked questions regarding Ordinance pertaining to parking vehicles at rental, non-owner occupied and unoccupied properties

On April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2021 Cayce City Council passed an Ordinance regarding parking in front yards of non-owner occupied properties that will go into effect in 180 days (October 18, 2021).

- Who does this apply to? This ordinance applies to all rental, non-owner occupied and unoccupied properties.
- When will this go into effect? Enforcement will begin on October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
- What is the designated parking area? This is the area, other than the driveway, that vehicles are allowed to park. See the shaded area in the diagram below.



- Where can I park? Vehicles can only be parked parallel to the street, except when within a driveway.
- What if I have guests over? Temporary parking is allowed if the guests are parked in the designated parking area.
- Who will be held accountable if the property is found to be in violation of the ordinance? The tenant and owner of the property can both be held accountable for violating this ordinance.
- What is the penalty if the Ordinance is violated? The penalty can result in a Municipal Ordinance Summons in the amount of \$1,087.50.
