

## INVITATION TO BID

**RECEIPT OF PROPOSALS:** City of Cayce will receive bids for the Railroad Street and Holland Avenue Sewer Line Rehabilitation until 10:00 AM, May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at the City Hall located at 1800 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Cayce, South Carolina 29033. Bids will be opened and read aloud through remote access at 2:00 PM May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Information will be e-mailed to all participating bidders, write a valid e-mail address on the outside of the bid envelope for which to receive login instructions. **Bids must be dropped off at the window drop-off at City Hall.**

**PROJECT:** The project includes the replacement or rehabilitation of 2-manholes and the cleaning and Cured In-Place Pipe (CIPP) lining (including the reconnection of all existing services) of approximately 1,157-LF of existing 8 and 10-inch gravity sewer pipe near Railroad Street and Holland Avenue. This project is funded through the Lexington County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. All CDBG guidelines are to be maintained during the Construction and Project Closeout periods.

**BID SECURITY:** A satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the bidder and acceptable sureties in an amount equal to five (5%) percent of the amount of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

**OWNER'S RIGHT RESERVED:** No bid shall be considered unless the bidder is legally qualified under the provisions of the South Carolina Contractor's Licensing Law and has the appropriate classification for the work that is to be conducted. No bidder may withdraw his Bid within 90 consecutive days after the actual date of opening without consent of the Owner. The City of Cayce reserves the right to waive any informalities in the bidding or to reject any or all bids.
